

Did you know that ...

The Romans and Scandinavians, and Masons, contributed equal parts in the creation of the institution of Chivalry and that the Rite of Induction was in the Masonic form?

The first lodge founded in France was at Dunkirk, October 13, 1721 and was called "Friendship and Fraternity"?

The constitution of the Metropolitan Grand Lodge in Ireland dates from 1729?

Freemasonry was introduced into Prussia by Frederick II, having been secretly initiated at Brunswick while crown prince?

The French or Modern rite was established by the Grand Orient of France about the year 1786?
