

A Proposal for an Amendment to the United States Constitution

Whereas law-and-order is the bulwark of a civil society, and

Whereas society needs a police department to maintain and ensure the maintenance of law-and-order, and

Whereas certain elected officials have called for police departments to be defunded, and

Whereas said defunding of police departments will erode the ability of the police to maintain law-and order, and

Whereas erosion of law-and-order will directly threaten the survival of civil society, the following is hereby proposed:

That pursuant to Article Five of the United States Constitution, the United States Constitution be amended to include the following amendment:

Law-and-order is an inalienable right that shall not be abridged.

This amendment shall make any law, regulation or other similar measure that erodes or otherwise weakens the ability of the police to maintain law-and-order unconstitutional.
