**Functional independence is a contra-indicator for physical therapy.**

**By its very nature, physical therapy alone cannot relieve pain.**

**Physical training is used as a form of punishment.**

**A medical diagnosis is tentative until confirmed by appropriate diagnostic tests.**

**Physicians often misdiagnosis.**

**A medical referral between two physicians sharing the same office is a conflict of interest.**

**An appropriate medical referral involves two physicians who do not have a business relationship.**

**Medical care is a commodity.**

**Expensive medical care does not necessarily mean good medical care.**

**A physician who truly cares is like a diamond in the rough.**

**Don't expect miracles from a physician.**

**Physicians are not miracle workers.**

**In general, a medical plan should be as conservative as necessary.**

**Beware of the physician who hesitates.**

**Without a definite diagnosis, medical care at best is palliative.**

**Continuity of care is a function of accessibility.**

**Medical care is becoming increasingly bureaucratized.**

**A good physician respects the patient.**

**Except pursuant to a court order, an adult patient has an absolute right to refuse medical treatment.**

**Only a court can order medical treatment against a patient's will.**

**Except in dire emergencies, no physician should treat a minor without a parent or legal guardian present.**

**For a physician, there is no absolute immunity from liability.**

**Every invasive procedure is a potential liability lawsuit.**

**Beware of the physician who is too quick to employ the scalpel.**

**To formulate a diagnosis based on subjective symptoms is extremely poor medical care.**

**Diagnostic tests must be reliable.**

**Mass media is totally politicized.**

**There is no such thing as objective reporting.**

**All news stories are propaganda.**

**The free press is anything but free.**

**The media shapes public opinion.**

**Whoever controls the media shapes public opinion.**

**All news stories contain spin.**

**The mass media has its own political agenda.**

**The mass media picks winners and losers too.**

**Beware of the journalist who denies having a political bias.**

**Politics shapes the way news is reported.**

**News is nothing more than gossip.**

**The mass news media is open to abuse.**
